## The Goal

Enable Parishioners to **give 'electronically'**

- **What this means**, basically:
  - No checks or cash needed at Church
  - Funds are transferred from any bank account into a St. Paul's bank account.
- **How it works**, basically:
  - Parishioners use REALM to set up a donation.
  - St. Paul's receives the funds in its account.
- **The immediate benefits:**
  - **Reduce** the number of paper checks and manual processing.
  - **Reduce** fees incurred by current electronic methods (PayPal)

## How it works - overview

1. Parishioners are invited to activate their profile in **Realm**
2. Parishioners log in to the St. Paul's Realm system
3. Select "Giving"
4. Configure Funds Transfer details

## The base technology - ACS Realm

St. Paul's uses **Realm** by ACS Technologies.

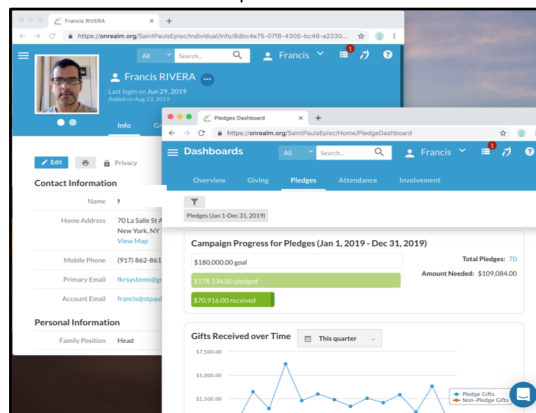
- We use the ACS church accounting software.
- Leader in the field

**Realm** is used for Parish Management:

- Address/Contact information
- Track donations/pledges
- Managing groups and communities

**Activating the Realm account is required for electronic giving.**

## Step-by-Step Setup Overview

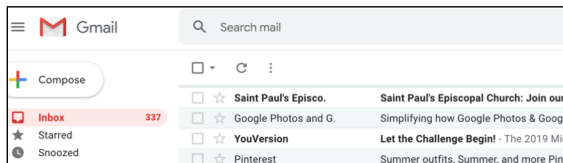
1. Parishioners **receive an email invitation** with the subject 'join our online community' from a St. Pauls email address
2. **Activate** your account on Realm (Create password)
3. **Verify** your account on Realm
4. Sign In to Realm
5. Review profile on Realm and **click “Giving”**
6. Use “Give” to **configure giving** options

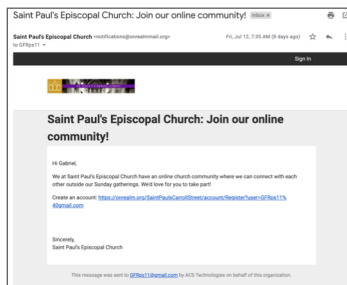

*(see screenshot 3.2 below)*



## 4. Sign In to Realm




After clicking the “Verify Me” button, you will log into the system using your email address and password

## 6. Use "+Give" to configure AND change gift details

## Behind the scenes - what's the cost?

The service is provided by a combination of products and vendors:

### Vanco

- Charges an EFT Processing fee
- 0.9%

### ACH (Automated Clearing House)\*

- Interbank system for transfers
- \*.35 per transaction/transfer

### Realm

- **No** additional fee over our current monthly subscription

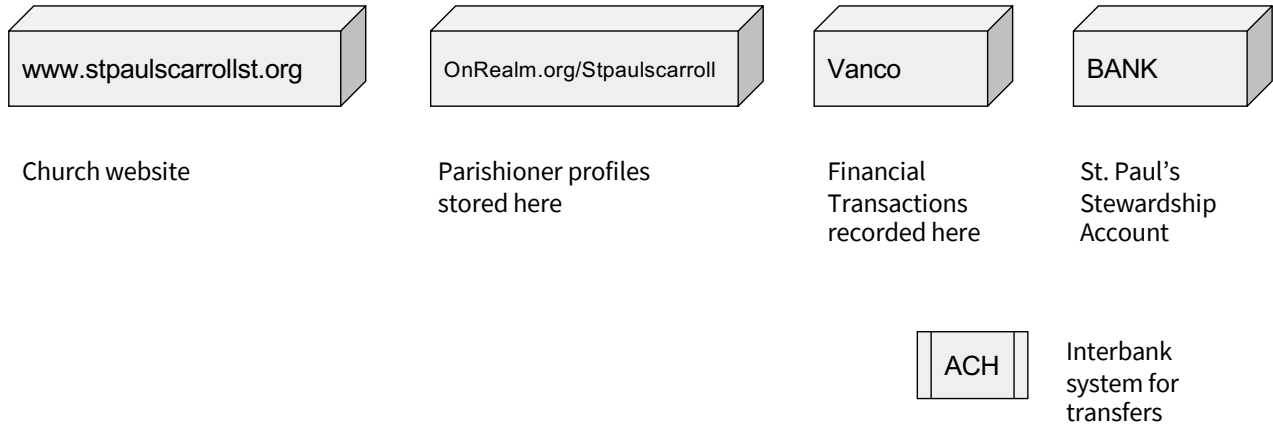

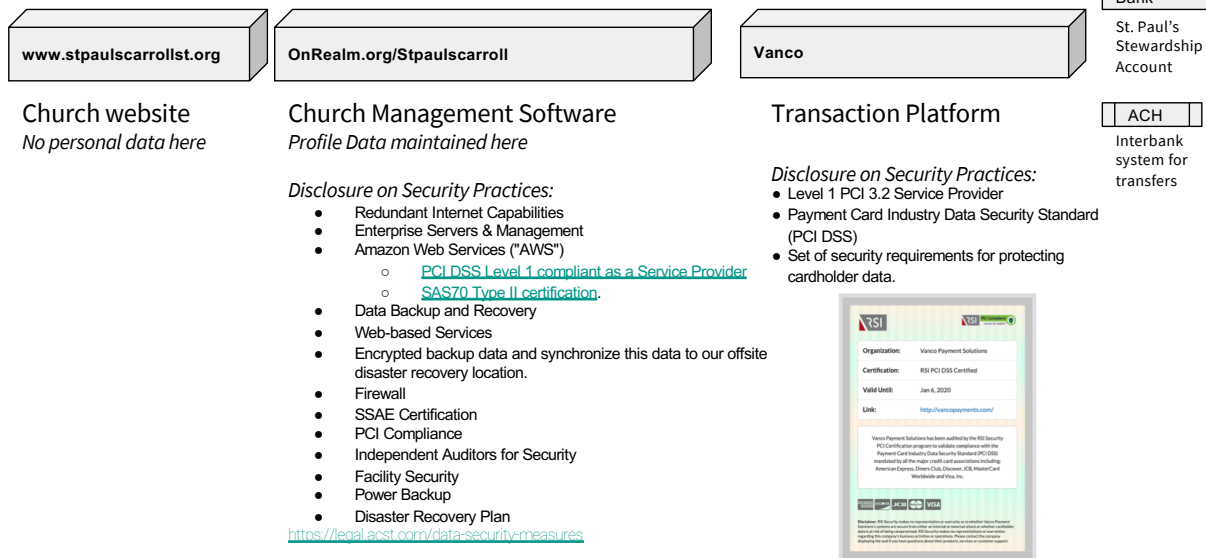
## Behind the scenes - The pieces of the system

If you have a Pledge number you will receive an invite (Date TBD)  
- You can request an invite sooner

If you would like to receive an invitation to join Realm and get a pledge number send an email with your name, postal address and phone number to [stewardship@stpaulscarrollst.org](mailto:stewardship@stpaulscarrollst.org)

Each member of the Parish can have a Realm profile. Some profiles will belong to families. The HEAD of that family (in Realm) can edit those profiles.

Each individual can manage their directory information, online giving, notification preferences and privacy settings directly online

Whom do I ask if I have a question about Realm?

Is my financial information private?  
The parish staff account and treasurer can see pledges and contribution history. No financial account information is captured or visible within Realm.
